
All entries need to be handed into your form tutor The deadline is 23<sup>rd</sup> October 2023. Your work must include your name, form, house and year group

Form tutors will collect and pass on any entries for #1 and #2 to Mrs Atherton in 84, latest end of Monday 13<sup>th</sup> November.

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
