Chancellor	leader of the government in Germany (Prime Minister in England)	
Fuhrer	German word for leader	
Indoctrinate	teaching people a particular set of ideas or viewpoints without questioning them

Kristallnacht	Night of the broken Glass	
Holocaust	a deliberate attempt by Hitler's Nazi Germany to eliminate Jewish people.	
Anti Semitism	hostility or prejudice against Jews as a religious or ethnic group.	
Ghetto	is a poorer part of a city in which members of a minority group live	
Penicillin	first mass produced antibiotic used during World War 2
