



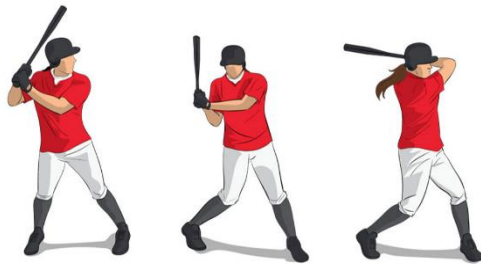

<b>Softball</b>	Equipment used in softball.	<p>Students will be BASE assessed on their practical skills related to Softball in isolation, small sided and recognised games.</p> <p><b><u>Quality of theoretical Understanding</u></b></p> <p>Students will also be assessed on their theoretical knowledge related to Softball. Including</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Rules and regulations</li> <li>• Skills and tactics</li> <li>• Analysis of performance</li> </ul>
<b>Softball Glove</b>	Equipment a fielder wears on one hand.	
<b>Bases</b>	One of four points on the infield that must be touched by a runner in order to score a run.	
<b>Home base</b>	The final base that must be touched by a runner to score a run.	
<b>Pitching Plate</b>	Where the pitcher pitches the ball from.	
<b>Catcher</b>	The catcher is the player who crouches behind home plate and catches the pitches that aren't hit by the batter.	<p><b>Family Learning Opportunities</b></p> <p><a href="https://www.britishsoftball.org/getinvolved">https://www.britishsoftball.org/getinvolved</a></p>
<b>Home Run</b>	When the ball is hit in such a way that the batter can circle the bases and reach home plate safely in one play without any errors being committed by the defensive team.	
<b>Strike</b>	A "strike" is called when the batter: Fails to swing at a pitch that crosses the plate in the strike zone, swings at a pitch and misses, hits the ball out of bounds with fewer than two strikes against them.	
<b>No Ball</b>	If the ball falls short of the home plate or hits the home plate, it is a no ball.
