



What are the rules and regulations in

- 2 teams of 7 players
- <u>Scoring</u>: 1 goal each time the ball passes through the net
- <u>Centre pass</u>: After each goal is score, play restarts with a centre pass.
- <u>Contact</u>: you must not interfere with play by touching or pushing an opponent.
- <u>Footwork</u>: You must not move your landing foot or take 3 steps whilst in possession of thttps://youtu.be/V1qlNnl-Dis?si=rmFllsDDUnmLlAaD he ball
- Held ball: You can only hold

the ball for 3 seconds.

- <u>Obstruction</u>: You must be 1 metre away from your opponent before your arms go up and over the ball.
- Offside: If you go in an area you're not allowed in, the umpire will call you offside
- Replaying the ball: You must not pick the ball up or bounce the ball if you have dropped it.

Held Ball	You are only allowed to keep hold of the ball for 3 seconds during the game at any one time.	
Footwork Pivot Landing foot	In Netball there is a footwork rule as to how you land when receiving the ball. Land 1,2. Your landing foot is the first foot that goes on the ground.	
Attacking Skills: Dodging Sprint Dodge Change of Direction Fake/Feint Dodge	Dodging is how you get free from a player in Netball to receive the ball. One way of getting free is to change directions, to beat your opponent to receive the ball.	Family Learning Opportunities

Goal Circle	Playing area where only GK, GD,GS and GA are allowed
