Divine Right of Kings	The idea that a King was appointed and given power by God.	Section 1: Previous Knowledge 20% - 6 1-mark questions. The Pope	The Head of the Catholic Church.	
Clergy	A group of religious people.	
Martyr	A person who is killed because of their religious or other beliefs.	Family Learning Opportunities
Archbishop	An important member of the clergy, below the Pope.	
Bishop	An important member of the clergy, below the Archbishop.	
Baron	A member of the nobility, pledged loyalty to the King in return for land.	
Taxation	A sum of money paid to the King.	
Public Heath	The general health and cleanliness of the whole population.	
Bubonic Plague	Type of plague – produced painful swellings (buboes) and was spread by rats.	
Pneumonic Plague	Type of plague – attacked the victim's lungs and was spread by personal contact.	
Peasant	A poor person, of low social status, who worked on the land.
