

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>What are the main types of passing in basketball?</li> </ul>  <p>What are the 5 positions in a basketball Team?</p> 	<p><b>What are the rules and regulations?</b></p> <p>2 teams of 5 players</p> <p>Scoring: If a shot is successfully scored from outside of the three-point line, three points are awarded.</p> <p>If a shot is successfully scored from inside of the three-point line, two points are awarded.</p> <p>If a team is awarded a technical foul, then they will receive between one and three free shots. Each shot scored will be awarded with one point.</p> <p>Contact: you must not interfere with play by touching or pushing an opponent.</p> <p>Double dribble: A player is no longer able to dribble with the ball once the player puts two hands on the ball. <b>Offensive foul</b>	An offensive foul in basketball is a foul committed by an offensive player whose team is in possession of the ball	
<b>Double dribble</b>	A double dribble in basketball is a violation that occurs when a player makes a controlled dribble, pauses, and then dribbles the basketball again	<b>What will the Assessment look like?</b>
<b>Defence</b>	A basketball defence refers to the defensive strategies, alignments, and positioning that a team uses to prevent the opposing offense from scoring.	<b>Quality of Performance</b> Students will be assessed on their practical skills related to basketball in isolation, small sided and recognised games.
<b>Contact</b>	Contact in basketball is when a player guards tightly or hits an opponent.	
<b>Free throw</b>	In basketball, free throws or foul shots are unopposed attempts to score points by shooting from behind the free-throw line	
<b>Marking</b>	Man-to-man defence in basketball is a type of defensive formation and tactic where every defensive player is assigned an offensive player to defend against	<b>Quality of theoretical Understanding</b>
