

| Key Term | Definition | |
| Abrahamic Religions | Religions that trace their origins to Abraham, like Judaism, Christianity, and Islam. | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - At the end of this unit pupils will have an assessment made up of multiple-choice questions and an extended writing task. |
| Parable | A simple story with a moral or spiritual lesson | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Go to your local library and look at Children's Bible stories that include Noah's Ark, Good Samaritan, the Prodigal Son and the story of Easter |
| Prodigal | Someone who spends recklessly or behaves irresponsibly but later returns home | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Have a look on YouTube at Saddleback Kids- they have lots of educational videos explaining key Biblical stories in a fun way! |
| Reconciliation | Making peace and fixing broken relationships. | |
| Commemorate | To honour and remember something important. | Challenge Opportunities |
| Resurrection | Coming back to life after death. | |
| Easter | A Christian celebration of Jesus' resurrection. | |
| Crucifixion | A form of execution where someone is nailed to a cross, like Jesus was. | |
| Isa | The name for Jesus in Islam. | |
| Incarnate | When a god or spirit takes on a human form. | |
| Depiction | A picture or representation of someone or something. | |
| Covenant | A sacred promise or agreement with God. | |
| Commandment | A rule or law given by God, like the Ten Commandments. | |
