

Abrahamic Religions	Religions that trace their origins to Abraham, like Judaism, Christianity, and Islam.	
Parable	A simple story with a moral or spiritual lesson	
Prodigal	Someone who spends recklessly or behaves irresponsibly but later returns home	
Reconciliation	Making peace and fixing broken relationships.	
Commemorate	To honour and remember something important.	Challenge Opportunities
Resurrection	Coming back to life after death.	
Easter	A Christian celebration of Jesus' resurrection.	
Crucifixion	A form of execution where someone is nailed to a cross, like Jesus was.	
Isa	The name for Jesus in Islam.	
Incarnate	When a god or spirit takes on a human form.	
Depiction	A picture or representation of someone or something.	
Covenant	A sacred promise or agreement with God.	
Commandment	A rule or law given by God, like the Ten Commandments.
